Heart Care Programme	<p>The Heart Care Programme is a healthcare programme including specialist case management, remote health monitoring and oversight of treatment interventions, delivered by our partner provider, Care-Connect. This programme may be suitable for members who have been diagnosed with Heart Failure and where their condition is stable.</p> <p>Members on the programme will be provided with a blood pressure cuff and weighing scales, shown how to take their measurements and will be required to input these into the Care-Connect app twice a week. Chronic Obstructive Airways disease (COPD) Programme	<p>The COPD Programme is a healthcare programme including specialist case management, remote health monitoring and oversight of treatment interventions, delivered by our partner provider, Care-Connect. This programme is suitable for members who have been diagnosed with COPD.</p> <p>Members on the programme will be provided with equipment required to take their measurements and will be shown how to take their measurements and will be required to input these into the CareConnect app in line with their presenting symptoms.
